Plus we may have a few surprises thrown in as well for good measure!

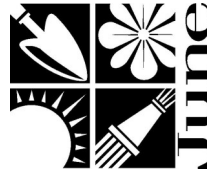
Family Night Out - July 23rd we will have another for Birth - 5th grade families in the gym.

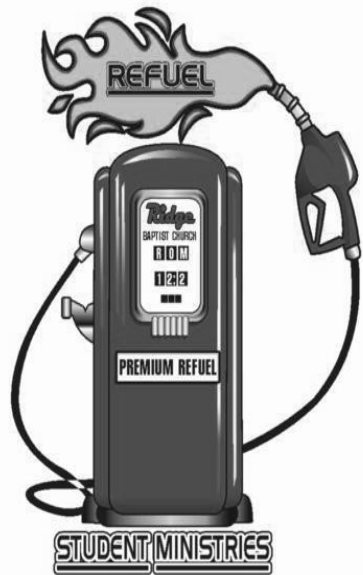

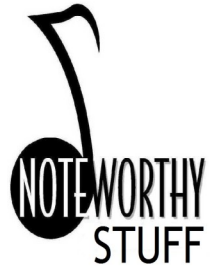

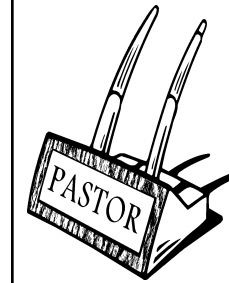
