### **Galatians 4:4**

So what can we learn about God from this Scripture:

#### **Time is the experience of man in a world lost in sin.**

**Ecclesiastes 3:1** - There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven.

#### **Time is in God's hands not ours.**

**2 Peter 3:8** - But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day

**Acts 1:7** - He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority

#### **Trust in God is essential as we wait on God.**

**Isaiah 40:31** - but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint
