Title: In His Name Text: John 16:23-28

In Scripture we read, "In my name," "In Jesus' name," or "In His name."

The devils were powerless because of His name (Luke 10:17).

The demons were cast out in His name (Mark 16:17-18).

Healing occurred in His name (Acts 3:6, 3:16, 4:10).

Salvation comes in His name (Acts 4:12, Romans 10:13).

We are to baptize in His name (Matthew 28:19).

We are justified in His name (1 Corinthians 6:11).

Everything we do and say is done in His name (Colossians 3:17).

Jesus has invited, urged, and commanded us to pray in His name and has promised incredible results.

When most of us pray we conclude with the phrase, "in Jesus' name."

But what does it mean to pray in the name of Jesus?

When we pray in Jesus' name:

- 1. We are admitting that our name is powerless.
